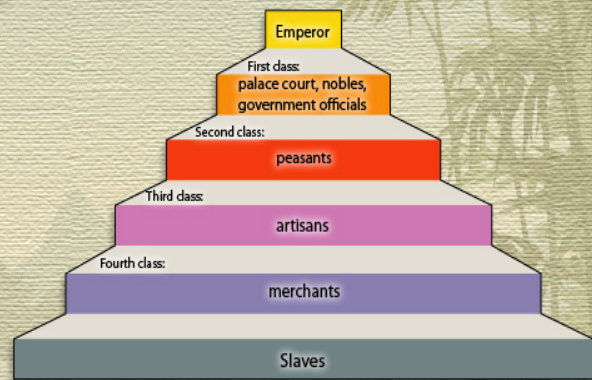


Qin Dynasty Economy
